Moreton Sixth Dress Code and Sports Uniform List

A Guide for Parents and Students





Moreton Sixth sets the standard for all the girls in Moreton Hall and as members of the Sixth Form you are the leaders of the school.

During the working week which includes not only lessons, but private study periods, mealtimes and Saturday mornings, dress should be the following:

- · Formal shirts, blouses, T-shirts or long sleeve T-shirts
- · Jumpers or cardigans
- Skirts and dresses must be no shorter than two inches above the knee
- One smart outfit or suit required for formal occasions. A skirt, tailored trousers or a shift dress may be worn with a jacket. Girls may well be asked to purchase an alternative suit if they do not fulfil this requirement. NB Suits will be required for all formal occasions such as Open Days, Speech Days, Carol Service etc.
- It is advisable to have a plain formal coat for colder weather
- Compulsory for A Level Art students: Art apron

At the end of the working day and once lessons are over home clothes are suitable.

Please Note...

- Uggs, sliders and flip flops
- · Brightly coloured / dyed hair
- Acrylic nails but gel polish of one, modest colour accepted (no nail polish allowed for students who are on the Leith's course)
- Piercings other than earrings
