The Youngest Ones 6 months – 2 years

First Steps has a separate room for babies and children under 2 years, called the Caterpillar Room.

This generous space includes room for construction, crafts, sand and water activities, as well as a 'home' corner. In addition, there is a stimulating sensory room that allows for exploration and quieter activities, such as sharing books with a grown up and exploring treasure baskets.

The sleep room, equipped with cots for nap time and quiet rest, allows us to follow your baby's resting routine as closely as possible. Doors from the main play space open onto our garden, so children can experience free-flow play between inside and outdoors.

Near to their second birthday, the children move on to the Butterfly Room.



What is a Key Person?

Upon entry to First Steps, each child is assigned a Key Person. This person is the main carer for your child in their first years. The Key Person is responsible for ensuring that your child's care meets their particular needs and interests. They will observe your child during their play and plan appropriate activities to enhance their experiences.

The Key Person also tracks your child's development and keep you informed of their progress.

A Day in First Steps

First Step's timetable offers a wide variety of activities and learning opportunities for your child.

Throughout the day, children take part in circle time and adult-led activities balanced with child-initiated play supervised by adults.

Small groups are led by the Key Person who plans appropriate activities based on the interests of the children. These activities are fun and interactive and link to the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

The routines and activities that fill each day strive to:

- Ensure the safety of each child
- Help children feel they are a valued member of the community
- Help children gain from social experiences as part of a group
- Provide children with opportunities to learn and value learning







Snacks and Meals

Moreton Hall's outstanding kitchen team provides children in First Steps with a prepared lunch and tea, along with nutritious snacks - all made with fresh local ingredients. The kitchen caters to all dietary needs. Weekly menus are displayed in First Steps and can be emailed if you prefer.

Meals are included in the daily fee.

Breakfast club is available from 7:30am. There is a small charge for breakfast and places must be booked in advance.

Rest Time

As each child has their own sleep and rest needs, we work closely with parents to establish a sleep routine that reflects the preferred schedule at home.

The warm atmosphere evident throughout the setting provides all children with a sense of belonging, and they learn to care for and respect each other in a safe and secure environment. **?**

The Middle Year 2 - 3 years

By 2 years of age, your child's grasp of language develops as their vocabulary expands and they understand more. 2 year olds have a dedicated room called the Butterfly Class.

2 year olds can follow simple instructions and grow a love of books. We add Forest School and Gym Minis at this age to aid physical develop a hands on love of the natural world.

At First Steps we encourage your child to expand their abilities and grow confident in acquiring new skills. We also provide crucial play time which allows them to develop their skills and discover the world at their own pace.

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The Pre-Prep Year

3 - 4 years

At the age of 3, children move into Pre-Prep at First Steps.

Pre-Prep is taught by First Steps staff, and accommodated in Moreton's Prep School. The pupils wear Prep School uniforms and participate in a greater variety of planned activities that prepare them for their first year of school.

All children in Pre-Prep are offered an extensive selection of activities in addition to the Early Years Foundation (EYFS) curriculum.

- Forest School
- PE lessons, both in Moreton Hall's Sports Hall and extensive outdoor sports facilities
- French, Chinese and Welsh delivered by specialist language teachers
- Music, Singing and Drama lessons which include preparation for concerts
- Cookery classes

In addition, Swimming and Ballet lessons are offered for an additional fee. The swimming lessons are held in the Moreton Hall pool and ballet lessons take place on Wednesday mornings and are taught by a qualified ballet teacher.


4's Club

Mini Holiday Club for Pre-Prep

Pre-Prep follows Moreton Prep's term time scheduled.

When your child turns 3 years old, they are welcome to join our Holiday Club, which provides an extended provision exclusively for Pre-Prep pupils during school holiday mini breaks.

Children undertake a wide range of activities, including daily swimming sessions, arts and crafts, cooking and a variety of sports.

Registration and Opening Hours

Children can be registered for First Steps Nursery as soon as you decide you would like them to attend.

We encourage you to come for a visit to get a good feel for what we can offer your child and absorb the relaxed, family atmosphere.

Groups are kept small and intimate, with a high ratio of staff to children maintained at all times to enable each child to receive outstanding care and attention.

First Steps runs a pre-visit system which is designed to help each child settle into the nursery environment. A few weeks before your child is due to start at First Steps you will be invited to come along and meet your child's Key Person. This provides the opportunity for you to share vital information about your child with your Key Person and allow your child some time to explore the environment while you are close by.

After this initial visit further visits will be arranged and will provide the opportunity for you to leave your child in our care for short periods of time to help them become familiar with the surroundings. We adapt the settling-in process to meet the needs of each child.
